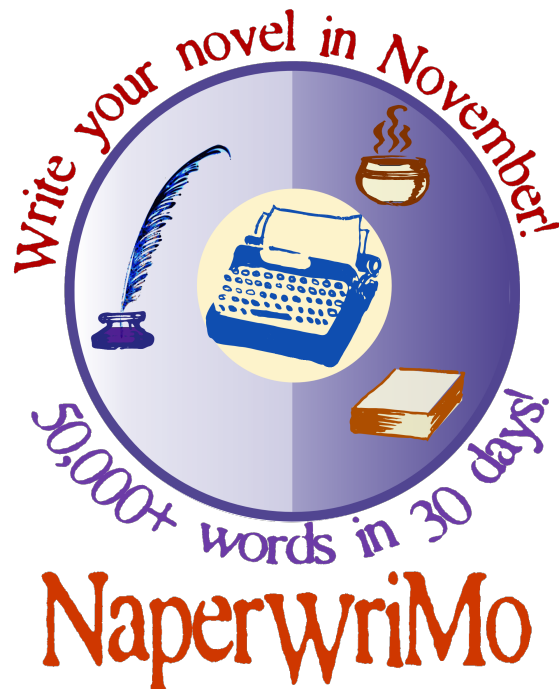


Do you have a dream of writing your novel some day?
